Good afternoon Heather,

Per our phone conversation, here is some guidance for community pools and gyms. **Pools that are not staffed, such as yours, will be able to reopen in phase 3.** Currently we are in phase 2. To help prepare for reopening, please review the [COVID-19 Prevention Guidance and Reopening of Water Recreation Facilities in Phases](#) from the Department of Health. Gov Inslee has fitness guidelines: <https://www.governor.wa.gov/sites/default/files/COVID19Phase2FitnessGuidelines.pdf>. **Phase 2 authorized operations include appointment-only one-on-one personal training and small group fitness sessions (groups of 5 or less) at private specialized training facilities. The independent use of machines without a personal trainer is not allowed in phase 2.**

COVID-19 is affecting our work.

Your health and our staff's health are our top priorities. Many of our staff are responding to the outbreak and others are working remotely to serve your needs. You will likely experience slower-than-normal response times for requests not related to COVID-19.
